

# 2024 Youth Contest Opens February 15, 2024 Closes April 15, 2024

# **Rules**

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND FOLLOW THESE RULES TO ENSURE YOUR POEM IS INCLUDED IN THE CONTEST.

Open to all Arizona students, grades 1-12 *with <u>no</u> entry fee for the contest*. Poems can be on any topic with a limit of three submissions per person. <u>Poems written in other than English must include an English translation.</u> <u>Please proofread</u> <u>your work thoroughly.</u>

#### SUBMISSIONS: Email is preferred, but can be accepted through mail:

- **EMAIL:** attach a copy of the poem to your email. **Do NOT put your name and address on the poem**. In the body of your email, please enter the **Title of the poem with your name, address, school, grade/age, email & phone.**
- MAIL: enclose a <u>copy of the poem</u>, <u>and a second sheet</u> with the **Title of the poem with your name, address**, school, grade/age, email & phone. <u>Do NOT put your name and address on the poem</u>
- Each entrant must make a declaration of originality. Include the following statement in your submission email or on the second page with your name/address/age. Poems without this declaration will be disqualified.

"I certify that this poem is my original work and has not been copied in whole or part from any author's poems or poetic work in print, posted on the Internet, or any other form."

FORMAT: All poems should be typed (Times New Roman font, 12 pt) or hand printed very clearly.

- Poet's information should be clearly typed or printed in English only, on 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> x11 plain white paper, <u>without lines</u> <u>or illustrations</u>.
- Poems can have <u>a maximum of 40 lines per poem</u> and a <u>limit of 50 characters per line</u>. <u>Spaces or breaks between</u> <u>stanzas will count as a line</u> but poem title does not count as a line.

DEADLINE: Entries must be Emailed by midnight, April 15, 2024, OR postmarked by April 15, 2024.
